At two pilot plants in Ludwigshafen and Evionnaz, BASF converts laboratory and kilo-scale processes to industrial scale. 11 production plants for commercial production are available at Evionnaz, Saint-Vulbas and Minden. Reactor volumes ranging from 1,000 to 10,000 l mean exceptional versatility.
